













## Camera Angles

The camera angle is the angle at which the camera is placed relative to the subject.

<p><b>LOW ANGLE</b></p> 	 camera is looking up  subject looks large  angle creates the impression of power in subject
<p><b>NORMAL OR STRAIGHT ANGLE</b></p> 	 camera is at eye-level of subject  subject looks even with, or equal to, viewer  angle makes viewer feel equal to subject and may even cause viewer to identify with subject
<p><b>HIGH ANGLE</b></p> 	 camera is looking down  subject appears small  angle creates the impression of weakness in subject
